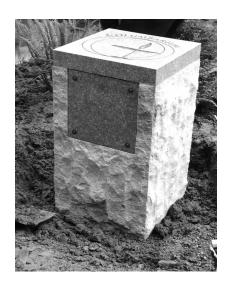
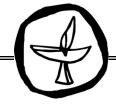
COLUMBARIUM INTERMENT

The Columbarium within the Memorial Garden is set aside for interment of the human cremains of members, family members, and pledging friends of the congregation.

There is no fee for the interment of cremains in the Columbarium.

If you would like to arrange for use of the Columbarium, fill out a Request for Columbarium Interment, available on OUUC's website or in the office. The request must be approved by the Minister or the Church Administrator. If you would also like a memorial service, the Minister and a member of the MSC will work with you or the family requesting interment.

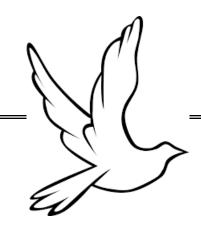

MEMORIAL SERVICES

The death of a loved one is often a highly stressful time for family and close friends who are coping with deep emotions while still having to organize the practical details of a memorial service.

The Olympia Unitarian Universalist Congregation is available to support its members and friends through this difficult period.

This brochure outlines the special services available and gives information on whom to contact for further details.



HOW CAN WE HELP?

If you are a member or pledging friend of OUUC:

The Memorial Services Committee (MSC) is available to help manage the details of the service and reception. The Church facilities may be used without charge by members and pledging friends of OUUC. There is no fee for the participation of the Minister, Music Director, or MSC in these services. However, donations to OUUC are gratefully accepted.



If you are not a member or pledging friend of OUUC:

The MSC does not manage the details of services and receptions for non-members or non-pledging friends. Please contact the Church Administrator regarding rental fees for the use of church facilities in order to make your own arrangements.

HOW TO WORK WITH THE MEMORIAL SERVICES COMMITTEE (MSC)

ARRANGING FOR A MEMORIAL SERVICE

- 1. Contact the Minister to discuss date, time, and service elements such as speakers, readings, memories, music, and printed program.
- 2. The Minister will confer with the Music Director regarding musical needs.
- 3. The Minister will contact the Memorial Services Committee (MSC) regarding service requests.
- 4. The MSC will meet with the family to discuss details including set-up, seating, flowers, memorial displays, slide shows, ushers, refreshments, and other details.

WHAT TO EXPECT THE DAY OF THE SERVICE

- 1. The Memorial Services Committee (MSC) will be the first to arrive at the church, to make sure everything is ready for the family and friends of the deceased.
- 2. A private room will be available for the family to use during their time at the church.
- 3. MSC members will be available for guests who may need help navigating church facilities.
- 4. The MSC will manage the details of the service as previously arranged.
