TIPS FOR CLASS LEADERS OUUC Adult Faith Development

The Adult Faith Development Team & class steward will assist in coordinating:

- Advertising
- Registration
- Communication with participants
- Access to the building at your class times
- Coordinate room and equipment reservations
- Classroom set-up + tech support
- Make copies of your printed material, if needed

Tips for class leaders:

- Relate all content and activities to your class description.
- Send a welcome email to your class participants (in coordination with your class steward) at least 7 days before the first class meeting.
- Arrange seating and adjust volume so everyone can easily see and hear.
- If you need to cancel or change the date of one of your sessions, contact the class steward assigned to your class as soon as possible and notify class participants.
- Begin the first session with introductions and a brief overview of the nature and objectives of the class.
- Please display the poster conveying classroom etiquette guidelines stored in the AV closet in classroom 3.
- Class evaluation forms are available from the class steward.
- Choose printed and electronic materials that are up to date.
