OUUC engages with many issues as part of putting our Faith into Action. It is how we answer the call of love and put our values into action.

Historically, OUUC has been strongly engaged in responding to homelessness, has earned certification as both a "Welcoming" (LGBT affirming) Congregation and a Green Sanctuary (responsible environmental care).

Our current focus areas for Faith in Action at OUUC are: Environmental Justice, Economic Justice, and Anti-Racism/Anti-Oppression. We have standing teams to shepherd work in these focus areas.

Additionally, as Unitarian Universalists we are engaged with a larger network of people of faith engaged in justice work, with Interfaith Works, Faith Action Network, JUUstice Washington, the Unitarian Universalist Service Committee, Side with Love, and more.





Environmental Action Team

Also affectionately known as "EAT", this team currently meets on the 1st Tuesday of the month at 5:30pm, in person.

A larger team, the EAT is engaged around a variety of environmental issues, from divestment in fossil fuels to helping us properly recycle at OUUC.

Social Justice Team

The purpose and mission of the Social Justice Team at OUUC is to affirm and emphasize the ways in which we are interconnected, in order to promote justice and combat disparity in racial, economic, and other areas in our community.

We will strive toward this goal by: informing the congregation and others of like mind about social justice issues and activities; connecting social justice activists to each other, to allies, and to institutional support; and demonstrating and encouraging behaviors that engage and welcome all.
